Center for the Study of 19th Century America
Research Grant
(Deadline: January 15)

Two grants of up to \$1,200 will be given by McKee Library's Center for the Study of 19th Century America to those individuals committed to doing scholarly research regarding a facet of 19th Century American history. This money is intended to be used for travel expenses to libraries or archives within the United States.

Eligibility requirements:

- Must be a Southern Adventist University student or faculty.
- Students must have the endorsement of a Southern Adventist University faculty member.
- Research must somehow relate to 19th Century America.
- Must be willing to upload final research paper to Southern Adventist University's institutional repository, KnowledgeExchange@Southern (www.southern.edu/knowledgeexchange) within one year of grant award. If this is not done, you will not be eligible for this grant in the future.

Necessary paperwork:

- Application form
- Research Proposal – In 500 words or less, describe your intended research focus and how it relates to 19th Century America as well as your research plan.
- A detailed budget breakdown and total of all the travel expenses you will likely incur
- *For students:* a letter of recommendation from the faculty member who is mentoring you in your research

Important Information:

After your trip, you must provide McKee Library with an expense report and attached receipts. If you do not turn these in, the money granted to you will be considered taxable income.
