- The school year in which you are admitted to Teacher Education is the catalog in which your program requirements will begin. That catalog and any subsequent catalog will be binding.

- Student teaching admission is a separate process for which you must apply.
- **You must maintain a minimum, cumulative GPA of 3.00, as well as a minimum of 3.00 in your major and professional education courses.**
- You must take and pass all required Praxis II licensure exams for the state of Tennessee before you are admitted to student teaching – both the Principles of Learning & Teaching (K-6, 5-9, or 7-12) and your specialty area tests.
- Denominational certification requirements are built into the program. However, you must officially apply for both types of certification at the conclusion of Student Teaching.
