	All courses in professional education, major, and cognates met with a minimum grade of C.
	Minimum grade of C- in religion and health courses is required for SDA teaching licensure.
	2.75 minimum GPA (cumulative, major, and professional education. GPA in each of these areas is specified under Progress in Student Planner).
	Professional dispositions as defined by the Educator Disposition Assessment (EDA), at the "Criteria Met" level. A score other than "Criteria Met" will require a performance improvement plan.
	Evidence of CPR and First Aid certification (need not be current).
	Passing scores for all required Praxis II exams <u>received</u> by the following deadlines: For fall student teaching, <u>June 15</u> , for winter student teaching, <u>October 15</u> of the preceding year. If scores have not been received by these dates, student teaching will likely be deferred to the following semester that schools are in session.
	Compliance with the Americans with Disabilities Act. Candidates must, with or without reasonable accommodation (physically and mentally), be capable of performing the essential functions of the program.
