### Need-to-Know Hints (Important!)

§ 124 credit hours are required to graduate (you may have to take elective classes in order to accumulate 124 credit hours)

§ Course numbers indicate difficulty level and correspond to years: 100 level=Freshman, 200 level=Sophomore etc.

§ 100 & 200 level classes are Lower Division (LD); 300 & 400 level classes are Upper Division (UD)

§ Before registering for UD classes you must complete 40 LD hours, ENGL 101 & 102, Math 215

§ Concentrate on fulfilling general education requirements during your first two years
