- 3. Debrief NADCMC 2019 and hand off to the next Region hosting NADCMC 2020 Overviewed survey results.
  - a. Bill Cork concern over dropping annual awards and chaplain recognition
  - b. June Price student leaders appreciated balance of time in the schedule and the opportunity to connect with chaplains
  - Adrian Marston appreciated any time students were able to connect with chaplains.
  - d. Albert Handal would have appreciated a quieter facility for table discussions prior to general sessions.

- e. Kim Mann "chat and chew" at meal times with conversation cards to help begin a dialogue without a facilitator
- f. Mark Sigue valued the opportunity for students to network and connect
- g. Sam Leonor valued and appreciated the camp atmosphere, would value time for students to tour the closest university campus
- h. June Price would appreciate a designated student leader to help facilitate good dialogue at "Ministry Breakouts"; Kim Mann echoed this concern. Dilys Brooks suggested utilizing the host campus students as facilitators.
- Niesha Steinkie would value a reminder of the purpose of "Ministry Breakouts."
- j. Kevin Straine suggested we consider on offering students the opportunity to serve during the convention (even if it's just within our facility).
- k. Andrew Pileggi mentioned his students had a hard time choosing between forums. Kevin mentioned that we could work towards recording the forums and putting them up on a website afterwards (potentially a closed FB group).
- Kim Mann questioned how to plan for a more intentional celebration of Black History Month and diversified praise and worship team and song selection in the future.
- m. Reynold Acosta questioned if we could go back to a structure of having individual campus leaders lead praise and worship in a scheduled rotation.
- n. Dilys Brooks suggested we talk about inter-genre and intercultural worship.
- o. Kim Mann suggested in the registration process a place where student leaders can suggest a song they would like to see in the CMC playlist. Russ & Dilys mentioned that asking for this in the

- registration process would be too late. Russ suggested a music subcommittee.
- p. Adrian Marston suggested we have a breakout session specifically for worship leaders, as well as an intentional "jam session" for musician growth.
- q. Dilys Brooks mentioned it would be helpful to ask chaplains what kind of campus leaders they are planning on bringing to CMC so that planning subcommittees can plan forums/breakouts accordingly.
- r. Andrew Pileggi nominated Kevin to work with the planning team
- s. Kim Mann would like to see some intentional team building during recreational time instead of just so much free-activity, as well as seeing more intentional modeling of team building by chaplains.
- t. Albert Handal suggested we could utilize camps that have team building activities such as ropes courses.
- Sam Leonor asked for clarification on opening and closing of convention times and encouraged chaplain's commitments to maintaining these times.
