

## About Transition and Support Program

“TSP” is a fee-based program designed for students who exhibit superior intellectual ability but face challenges in executive functioning and social interactions, however, **students with other forms of learning disabilities and/or ADHD may also benefit from this program.**

TSP works in conjunction with SOAR, a Disability Support Services club, whose purpose is to promote awareness and inclusion for all students. The goal is to transform perceptions and expand understandings of the challenges individuals with disabilities face.

### **TSP is available to all students.**

Support is individually tailored to match each student’s unique profile, TSP specifically focuses on improving each student’s social engagements and abilities as well as academic success. Because residential life provides the opportunity to learn social interaction, independent living and time management, students are strongly encouraged to live in the residence hall.

**ALL STUDENTS are part of the same community and have something valuable to contribute.**

## STUDENTS RECEIVE:

- Individual and group counseling sessions
- Optional meal gatherings
- Priority access to the on campus sensory room
- Help developing strategies to manage schedules, time management and organizational skills
- Help in coping strategy skills

## PARENTAL INVOLVEMENT

Parents may receive updates on a weekly or monthly basis or as requested if approved by the student.

The cost of the TSP program is \$2,500 per semester in addition to University tuition and housing fees. For more information, please see the DSS office.

## REGISTRATION

After the student has been accepted to the university, please contact us to request an intake packet.

Please note - this program does not replace the Disability Support Services “DSS” program. Students applying to TSP should also be sure to register with DSS if they would like to request:

- An academic accommodation such as a reduced course load.
- A single-room option that supports the opportunity to decompress and regulate (based on availability).
- An early move-in date that allows for a calmer transition from home to residence hall life.
