Purpose:	The purpose of this shortened scale is to assess nocturnal fears in adolescents.
Description:	The Fear of Sleep Inventory-11-item Short Form (FoSI-11; Hall Brown et al., 2019) was developed to be a reduced measure of adolescents' nocturnal fears. This shortened instrument was constructed through a psychometric evaluation of the original Fear of Sleep Inventory (FoSI; Zayfert et al., 2006). The resulting 11-item scale (FoSI-11) was evaluated in a sample of students from two urban school-based health centers. Instrument Type:	Inventory/Questionnaire
Format:	A 5-point Likert scale (3 = not at all to 4 = nearly every night) is used to identify the frequency of the occurrence of the listed items within the last month.

- View important information like test type, authors, publisher, publication, and more on the items record.
- Pay attention to the keywords used in the resources you find most helpful.
- Most items will include information on the reliability and validity of the test.
- The instrument type and format are typically listed within the item record.



## Finding the Full Text



Click on the title of the item of interest.



To find the full text, click PDF Full Text, the HTML Full Text, or the Get Full-Text button on the left-side of the screen.



- Download and save the PDF to your computer or bibliographic management tool.
- In some cases, the full text of the testing tool is not provided. Instead, an email address is listed for the primary researcher to request access to the instrument.
- Full-text not available? We will try to get it for you for free through interlibrary loan. Click "Get Full-Text" to go to the interlibrary loan request page.



## Tools

- Save to Google Drive or OneDrive to access record in the future.
- Email yourself a link to the article and record information. Note: this does not email the article's full-text.
- Select cite to view the citation of the item in your chosen format. These citations should always be double-checked for accuracy.
- To save a link to the article, make sure to use the permalink option.
