Conducting a Search



Select Advanced Search and enter your search terms in the boxes and click search.

Keyword & Full Text	contains	business
Keyword & Full Text	contains	Accounting

- Use the most important words and phrases of your research topic as keywords.
- Put phrases in quotation marks.
- If your results aren't relevant, try different combinations of keywords, including synonyms and related phrases.
- If you are finding too many results, use more specific search terms. If you are not finding enough results, consider using more broad search terms.



Focus Your Results



You can focus your results using the "Select a Field (Optional)" drop-down menu.

- Search in Ebook Central Subject to locate your terms in the controlled vocabulary.

Description
This book, first published in 1988, is a study of the development of accounting in eighteenth century Scotland. The investigation is organised around a survey of early Scottish accounting texts, an analysis of their exposition of the Italian method of book-keeping and their treatment of certain selected topics. The aim is to evaluate the contribution that these Scottish accountants made to the development of a profession.
