Code of Conduct

- 1. Prepare for the tutoring session.
- 2. Bring textbook, syllabus, test, notes, previous papers, current assignments, and any other material that will help the tutor understand what needs to be accomplished.
- 3. Tutoring sessions are by **appointment only** and **must** be arranged through Learning Support Services (LSS).
- 4. Expect the tutor to ask questions and make **suggestions**.
- 5. Your tutor will not do work that you should do, such as proofread.

- 1. I will meet my tutor at the agreed-upon times.
- 2. If I am unable to attend a tutoring session, I will notify my tutor at least 4 hours in advance.
- 3. If I miss more than two sessions, my tutorial services will be discontinued for the remainder of the semester. At my request, unusual or extenuating circumstances can be evaluated for **possible** continuation of my tutorial support.
- 4. I understand that tutorial services are **supplementary** to my classroom instruction and not a substitute for it and that my tutor will not teach material I missed by not attending class.
- 5. I agree to attend class regularly and complete my assignments on time.
- 6. I agree to try any new learning strategies my tutor teaches me.
- 7. I agree to evaluate the quality of tutorial service as requested by the LSS staff.
- 8. If the tutorial service I receive is not satisfactory or beneficial to me, I agree to discuss the situation with the LSS staff immediately.
- 9. I agree to allow the tutor to discuss my progress with the LSS staff. Outside of discussions with LSS staff, I understand that my tutor will keep details of my tutoring sessions **confidential**.
- 10. I agree to follow Southern's dress code as outlined in the student handbook.
